Pleasantville Public Schools is a culturally and economically diverse Pre-K through 12 district serving approximately 3,491 talented students, supported by 761 dedicated staff members, across six schools with an operating budget of more than \$126 million.

The total compensation package is anticipated to be regionally competitive and will be based on the candidate's experience and education. The initial contract will be for a multi-year term, as authorized by New Jersey statute
